We can win freedom for former Black Panther and political prisoner Mumia Abu-Jamal in 2019!

New developments have opened up avenues to build the struggle to fight for Mumia's release since he was framed and locked up 37 years ago for a crime he didn't commit. It has been the international movement in the streets that has made the difference in these decisive moments - and it's needed now more than ever.

On Dec 27, 2018 Judge Leon Tucker issued a historic ruling that Abu-Jamal had the right to new hearings on appeals previously denied. The next day, Philadelphia DA Larry Krasner 'discovered' six boxes containing files related to Mumia's case in a remote storage closet. This is more evidence that the DA's office continues to engage in a cover up of the frame up of Mumia that began 37 years ago. Since Tucker's ruling, thousands across the country have called on Krasner to not stand in the way of justice for Mumia. Mumia Abu-Jamal's frame-up stands out as the city's most notorious wrongful conviction.
